- Everything EAST of Jacksonville Road from the East Allen border SOUTH to and including Crawford Drive. Zone I:
- Zone II: Everything WEST of Jacksonville Road from the East Allen border SOUTH to Stoke Park Road.
- Zone III: Everything EAST of Jacksonville Road from Crawford Drive SOUTH to the City of Bethlehem border.

Zone IV: Everything WEST of Jacksonville Road south of Stoke Park Road SOUTH to the City of Bethlehem border. Jacksonville and Stoke Park Roads are collected in Zone IV

The pickup will start in the northern most part of each zone on MONDAY (unless noted) and proceed southerly. It may take multiple days to complete each zone. Yard waste must be curbside NO LATER than 7:00 a.m. on the dates noted above. The yard waste truck will make only one pass through each zone during the week identified. Material must be placed curbside either in the 92gallon Township container, other rigid containers, or Yard Waste Bags available at local retailers and home improvement stores. Containers other than the 92-gallon barrels provided by the Township must weigh less than 70 lbs. Yard waste placed in plastic trash bags will not be collected.

You can place your grass out for the regular trash collection, but this is not recommended by the Township or the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).
